

The lack of a united women's movement is a hurdle to working women's struggle for their rights at workplaces, a study by sociologists at the University of Agriculture Faisalabad (UAF) has concluded...The study said the representation of working women in trade unions was not commensurate with their numbers at the industrial units. It said that women workers were mostly given low-skill tasks and that lack of knowledge about their rights hampered them in articulating their demands effectively (...)
