

The second round of negotiations under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) in 2010 will take place from 31 May to 11 June at Hotel Martim in Bonn, Germany.

The meeting includes the 32nd sessions of the UNFCCC Subsidiary Bodies, which will meet from 31 May to 9 June. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) will consider issues including national communications and reporting, financial mechanism and capacity building. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) will consider, inter alia, methodological issues, technology transfer and the Nairobi Work Programme on impacts, vulnerability and adaptation to climate change.

The meeting also includes the twelfth session of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (AWG-KP) and tenth session of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Long-term Cooperative Action (AWG-LCA), which are scheduled to meet from 1 June to 11 June. The main item on the AWG-KP's agenda focuses on further commitments by Annex I countries. The AWG-LCA's agenda focuses on preparation of an outcome to be presented to the sixteenth Conference of the Parties (COP 16) and parties are expected to consider a new text prepared by the Chair to facilitate negotiations among parties.
